INTRODUCTION

Indira Gandhi College of Nursing is located in the heart of Kochi city. With the motto “knowledge with mission” the management aims to provide quality Nursing Education to the highest level to be a part with global standards. The college has excellent faculty and good infrastructure facilities. The faculty accepts its responsibility in helping the students to develop pride in their profession besides keeping them abreast with current knowledge and profession trends for a successful career ahead.

The college of Nursing included in this prospectus offer B.Sc. Nursing Degree programme of 4 years duration as specified by Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), approved by Indian Nursing Council & Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council.

II – Purpose

The main purpose of this course is to provide an educational program through which the graduate will be prepared to assume responsibility in the primary, secondary and territory care of people as professional Nurses. It is expected that graduates are capable of teaching and supervising appropriate Nursing and healthcare in different setting and participate in the administration of Nursing Services and Education.

III – Eligibility for Admission

3.1 Academic:

(i) Candidate who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or equivalent Examination recognized by any of the universities in the state of Kerala with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English put together are eligible for admission.

(ii) Relaxation in marks

- a. Candidates belonging to SEBC (Socially and Educationally Backward Classes) in the state of Kerala with total annual family income up to Rs.6

lakhs will have relaxation of 5% marks. The Scheduled Tribe candidates in the state of Kerala need only a pass in the qualifying examination.

b. Those candidates claiming relaxation of marks shall produce necessary certificates under Management Quota.

(iii) Eligibility certificates: Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from places other than state of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of qualifying examination from KUHS Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of interview for admission.

3.2 Age:

(i) Applicant should have completed 17 years of age on the 31st December in the admission year. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.

(ii) Self attested copy of relevant page of school record namely SSLC/ICSE/CBSE/ certificates showing the date of birth/copy of birth certificate should be furnished along with the application in proof of age.

3.3 Categorization of Seat

Government seats:- Merit seats against which the Director, LBS centre makes allotment are called Government Seats. Self-Financing Colleges and Private self-financing Colleges those are willing to share 50% of their seats with the Government.

3.4 Management Seats: - 35% Seats other than Government seats filled up by management

3.5 NRI seats: - 15 % of the management seats will be allotted for NRI candidates.

DOCUMENTS FOR NRI

- i. A candidate, who apply for the NRI seat should submit the Passport copy and Visa/Green card/OCI Documents of their respective sponsors. The job of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the above documents.
- ii. The visa of the sponsor should be valid till the closing date of admission in respect of the Medical and Allied Courses.
- iii. In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the above documents, the candidate has to produce the employment certificate of the sponsor attested by the Embassy/Consulate authorities.

- iv. The certificates clearly establishing the relationship of the sponsor with the candidate shall be obtained from the revenue authorities, as per the G.O (Ms) No.24/14/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014.
- v. However, the relationship between the candidate and his/her father/mother, which are recorded in the educational certificates, maintained in the usual course of transaction by the competent authorities, shall be accepted.
- vi. The Candidate shall produce the sworn affidavit from the sponsor in stamp paper worth Rs.200/-.The same shall also be notarized by the Notary public, disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and the all expenses i.e. tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the sponsor.
- vii. All the certificates/documents required to establish NRI Status/Non Creamy Layer/Minority etc. shall be produced at the time of submission of application itself. The certificate produce later shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

IV- HOW TO APPLY

Application for admission to B.Sc Nursing course can be registered only online through a single application. The provision for applying online is available at the website of www.igconkochi.com.

- **Submission of more than one application by a candidate will lead to rejection of the application for the same course submitted subsequent to the first application.**

4.1 Application Fee:

For all Candidates: - Rs 800/-only

- The application fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.

4.2 Availability of Prospectus

4.3 Important

- (a) Documents/Certificates furnished after submission of the application will not be entertained under any circumstances.
- (b) No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details or documents after the submission of application expect for those whose results are not declared before the last date of the submission of application.

V- Admission Procedure

5.1 Preparation of Merit list:

50% of government seats will be filled based on LBS rank list.

In 50% of seats, 35% seats will be filled by management from among the applications received and on the basis of marks obtained in the optional subjects (**Physics+Chemistry+Biology and English**) for the qualifying examination.

Remaining **15% NRI** seats shall be filled from qualified students as per G.O. The original documents shall be submitted at the time of admission.

5.2 Selection of procedure

Selection of the candidate will be done by the college from among the candidate who have applied in the college based on the marks obtained in the optional subjects (**Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English**) secured in the qualifying examination.

The open Merit rank list for B.Sc Nursing will be prepared on the basis of the percentage of the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in the qualifying examination. The Ranking is based on the percentage of marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English and the rank list will be published in the College Website.

Call letter for interview will be sent to each candidate from the college and oral interview will be conducted.

5.3 In the case of tie in the total marks, the marks in Biology will count. If there is still a tie the marks in Chemistry and Physics will count. If a tie still exists, the total score of the qualifying exam will be considered.

5.4 Inclusion in the merit list will not entitle the applicant eligible for admission to the cause, unless the applicant satisfy the rules regarding the eligibility for admission and other conditions as laid down in the prospectus.

5.5 Furnishing of false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

VI- Admission & Payment of fees

6.1 The selected candidates will be informed about the date and time of admission.

6.2 The students shall pay all fees of the 1st year of the course at the time of admission which will not be refunded. Fee stipulated by the fee regulatory committee/Govt. of Kerala is as follows:

Tuition fee Rs. 73,025/-

Special fee Rs. 23, 300/- First year and Rs.19, 300 from second year onwards.

Caution deposit Rs.10, 000/ (Refundable)

Other fees due to statutory bodied (KUHS, KNMC &INC) as and when notified. Hostel fee Rs. 3000/-(per month) and should be paid in advance in the beginning of the year.

Tuition fee for the NRI sponsored candidates will be of Rs. 95,000/- per year as per G.O.

Special fee Rs. 23,300/- First year and Rs.19, 300 from second year onwards

6.3 If any candidates discontinue the course, after closing of admission as notified by the authority, the candidate has to pay the full fee of the reaming course

(4 yrs). The collection of liquidated damages shall be as per the final decision of the AFRC or Court of Law.

VII – Special Instructions

- (a) **Ragging:** Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the college. Hence any student who indulges any form of ragging will be subjected to penal action as per provisions of law. Also the student will be expelled from the college as detailed in the law concerned and as per the Honorable Supreme Court of India directions in this regard.
- (b) **Use of mobile phone:** Use of mobile phone by students are not allowed in the campuses and hostels of the college. Any violation of this prohibition will lead to stringent disciplinary action by the college authorities.
- (c) Any other items not specially covered in this prospectus will be decided by the undersigned, and his decision shall be final.

VIII – Undertaking regarding noninvolvement in ragging
